

.EDU.AU DOMAIN: WARRANTY FOR THIRD LEVEL DOMAIN FOR AN ORGANISATION

Instructions

- The following form is to be completed when applying for a third level domain name under the criteria listed in Schedule 2, Section 3.4 and 3.7 of the .edu.au Registration Policy.
- The “warranty by the applicant” section of this form must be completed by an authorised representative of the applicant and printed on the letterhead of the applicant or accompanied by photo id of the representative.
- The “warranty by the referee” section this form must be completed by one of the two referees nominated by the applicant and printed on the letterhead of the referee’s organisation or accompanied by photo id of the referee.
- The referees must be authorised representatives of current .edu.au licence-holders.
(this includes domains registered at any level in the .edu.au space – e.g. .edu.au, .nsw.edu.au, .vic.edu.au)
- The referees must be from two different entities that are not related entities to the applicant
(related entity as defined by the Corporations Act 2001, section 9 – e.g. not a parent company or subsidiary)
- Please send the completed pages to Education Services Australia via email to registrar@esa.edu.au.
- Upon receipt, your application(s) will be raised for review and processed. Notification of whether the application has been approved or rejected will then be sent to the email address provided as the account contact.

Please Note

As per published policy, Education Services Australia may contact the second referee to confirm the details provided.

In order to be eligible for a third level domain name the applicant must demonstrate that their organisation currently has national interests and responsibilities via delivering education and training services in more than one state or territory in Australia or by other means. The following are not considered to be national interests and responsibilities:

- Representing a group within a single state or territory jurisdiction at a national level
- A single state or territory based entity being a member of a national body or association
- International delivery of education and training services

Where a single state or territory based entity has a project or program that has national interests and responsibilities, eligibility for registration at the third level only applies to domain names that refer to the project or program.

All domain name licences are issued subject to mandatory terms and conditions and published policies. Non-compliance with such terms and conditions or published policies may lead to the cancellation of a domain name licence. Please see www.domainname.edu.au/policy.htm for full details.

Terminology

- Applicant: The legal entity put forward as the registrant for the proposed domain name(s)
- Licence-holder: The legal entity currently listed as the registrant for a domain name in the registry database
This can be viewed via the WHOIS lookup function at www.domainname.edu.au/whois.htm
- Domain level: Third level domain names are registered at a national level (i.e. <thirdlevel>.edu.au)
Fourth level domain names are registered at a jurisdiction level (i.e. <fourthlevel>.vic.edu.au)
