The registrant or account holder for a referee's domain may be contacted to confirm they are an authorised representative.

Declaration of primary function relates to the applying entity directly and as a whole, <u>not</u> that of a project or program belonging to the applicant or the intended purpose, content or services to be made available on the proposed domain name(s).

Providing general services <u>to</u> entities within the education and training sector does <u>not</u> qualify as "related services" as referred to in the declaration. Entities primarily providing such services are not eligible, including but not limited to:

- stationary, uniform, book or other supply services
- information technology, software or website development services
- marketing, referral, administration or financial services

Representing a group within a single State or Territory jurisdiction at a national level, a single State or Territory based entity being a member of a national body or association, and international delivery of education or training services are <u>not</u> considered to be national interests and responsibilities.
